TRACKING TEST AWARD

Each passing team will receive a green qualifying ribbon and a custom dog toy.

IMPORTANT NOTES TO EXHIBITORS

CERTIFICATION; With the entry form for a dog that has not passed an AKC Tracking Test, there must be filed a certification form dated within two years & signed by a person who has been approved by the American Kennel Club to judge tracking tests (or Provisional Tracking Judge), or by an evaluator who has earned a TDX or VST title within the past 10 years.

TEST LIMIT & DRAW: This test is limited to 3 TDU dogs and 3 VST dogs. Entries will remain open until THURSDAY, 4/25/2024 until 5:00 p.m. If entries received exceed the test limit, a public drawing will be held THURSDAY, 4/25/2024, at 6:00 p.m. at Starbucks, 940 Baptist Rd, Colorado Springs, CO. Any interested parties may attend. Acknowledgment will be mailed to all entrants as soon as practicable. If alternate entries remain after the draw, an additional draw will be conducted to determine the order in which alternates will run. In all cases, preference will be given to Belgian Sheepdogs first, followed by all other breeds.

The exchange rule will be applied according to Chapter1, Sections 17a AND 17b, and with the consideration of what the site will allow.

ENTRY FEE: TDU -- \$75.00 VST -- \$135 (in US dollars). (This includes the 50 cent AKC recording fee & the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee.) Make checks **payable to BSCA** & send, with certification for TDU entries, to the Event Secretary, Beth Elliott, 16375 Roller Coaster Rd., Colorado Springs, CO. 80921

ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is withdrawn from the test after the closing date, absent, disqualified, excused by judges or barred from competition by the test committee, unless an alternate exhibitor is available & willing to take the spot of the exhibitor. If, because of storms or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete this event, no refund of entry fees will be made, except as allowed in the Tracking Regs, Chapter 1, Section 11. Cancellation of entries must be made in writing or e-mail to the Test Secretary & must be received by the Secretary prior to the closing date. Entries sent by **OVERNIGHT DELIVERY** must be marked "no signature required".

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE under the conditions stated in the AKC Tracking Regs, Chapter 2, Section 8.

USE THE OFFICIAL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB ENTRY FORM & write "Tracking" in the "Obedience Trial Class" space. Telegraphed, telephoned, unsigned, conditional or incomplete entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form & photocopies of forms without the Agreement & Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

THE ORDER OF RUNNING will be determined by a draw for tracks at the time called for on the face of this premium list.

BSCA does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry forms for these events.

RISK: The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk & agrees to abide by all of the Rules & Regulations of the American Kennel Club. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (std, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim & Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, std).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered & shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record & dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.
